



Job Description: Watershed Restoration Project Assistant

Pay range \$16.00 - \$18.00 per hour depending on experience.

Work Hours: Full time. Flexible schedule required, limited duration employment.

Who may apply: Anyone 18 years or older and authorized to work in the United States. Experience in Biology or related field as well as field experience preferred.

Duration: March 15th through September 15th, 2021. SRWC may be flexible on start and end dates. This is a temporary position with possible extension of term duration. Office located outside of Reedsport.

The Smith River Watershed Council is seeking qualified applicants for a Watershed Restoration Project Assistant. The employee will assist the Council's Executive Director with management and development of in-stream habitat restoration projects.

Employee duties include but are not limited to the following:

- Lead inventory of Umpqua basin tide gates and estuary habitats
- Assist with project and program implementation
- Inspect properties for target invasive species
- Collect and manage field survey data
- Coordinate with and supervise contractors
- Landowner outreach and communication
- Participate in meetings involving district staff, project partners and board members

Employee must be capable of working in inclement weather for up to 10 hours per day. Employee must also be able to work independently over remote and rough terrain in adverse weather conditions. Position will require field work via boat with contracted operator. Per Diem will be paid for overnight travel. Work will be approximately 50% field work and 50% office work.

Employee must have a valid Driver's License and complete an Employment Eligibility Verification (I9). Applicants must submit a current resume and three references to be considered. Applications must be submitted in full by 5pm February 17th, to the email address below.
